

LITTLE RED RIDING HOOD



CRAFT

This is a good craft for your kids to make while you read the story. OR, attach a popsicle stick to the tp roll to make a Red Riding Hood puppet that they can use to turn the story into a puppet show!

The craft is made with a toilet paper tube, a printer, a piece of paper, some crayons, scissors, and glue. I always prefer to use a heavy paper (like construction paper), but it isn't necessary.

- Print out the template of choice. If printing the black and white template, try printing on red construction paper.
- Colour (where appropriate) and cut out the template pieces.
- Glue the large rectangular piece on first to cover the tube. You may wish to trim the tp roll down a little bit to get her proportions right.
- Glue on the head, arms, and cloak.
- Fold the tabs of the feet and glue to the inside of the tp roll.

Close the template window after printing to return to this screen.

- Sometimes it may say "No pages available to print".
 - This happens with some browsers and means that you've printed or print previewed once already.
- If you get this message, hit RELOAD or REFRESH and try printing again.


Wolf Toilet Paper Roll Craft



This is a good craft to make with the TP roll [pig](#) (the three little pigs) or with [Little Red Ridinghood](#).

Materials you will need for the big, bad wolf are a tp roll, printer, glue, scissors, something to colour with and a piece of paper (I prefer construction paper).

- Print out the template of choice.
- Colour the pieces as appropriate and cut them out.
- Glue the large rectangular piece around the toilet paper tube.
- Glue the tail onto the back of the tp roll using the tabs to make a 3D effect.
- Glue the head onto the front of the tp roll.
- Glue on the paws. We usually make the crafts so they look like they are sitting on their haunches.
